

## **Multispecies swards**

■ Any sward that contains more than one plant functional group

- Grass, legume, brassica, herb
- Most common multispecies swards are perennial ryegrass & white clover mixtures

### Why?


- Increased herbage digestibility
- •Increased animal and sward production
- •Legumes fixing atmospheric nitrogen
- ●60% reduction in fertilizer inputs
- ♦50% reduction in ammonia emissions




#### **Plants to consider**

- Chicory
- •Deep rooting, drought tolerant
- Plantain
- •Winter growth, reduce nitrate leaching
- •Red clover
- •Increase herbage growth, nitrogen fixing

# Multi Species Grass Scheme 2022

Min area of 1 hectare and a maximum area of 20 hectares will apply

A payment rate of €50 per 12kg bag of multi-species sward mixture will apply

Planting must be completed prior to the 31st of August

All invoices must be between date of approval and August 31st

Merchant will collect the subsidy from Dept and price you pay for the Seed will exclude this €50/bag.

You can only purchase seed from the list approved by Dept

## **Red Clover Silage Measure**

The red clover silage sward must be grown to commercial requirements and sown at the recommended seeding rates of at least 30kg/ha

A minimum area of 1 hectare and a maximum area of 20 hectares

The mixture must include 4kgs of Red Clover for each 12kg pack.

The balance of the seed mixture must contain either Perennial Ryegrass or Hybrid Ryegrasses and may contain some White Clover.

The red clover silage sward must be successfully established by 30th September 2022.
